# Dance & Music Workshop in Romani Mahala, Berovo, North Macedonia With Šani Rifati & Milo Destanovci, August 14th — August 21st, 2025

is a small town in the Malishevo mountains (1100 yds above sea level), known for its fresh air, delicious food, and last but not least, some of the best Romani musicians in the Balkans !

The Romani Mahala (neighborhood) in Berovo has been rich in traditional music and dance since the "60s, when many Roma migrated from Ratevo to Berovo. Famous musician families Destanovci, Kanturuski, and Demirovski are at home in Berovo. Other Roma families, Kanturski, and Alimanovski made up much of the world acclaimed Balkan brass band, Kocani Orkestar.

Stores, restaurants and bars are within walking distance of the Mahala, as well as old monasteries around that you can visit. There is also a clear lake in the woods for a refreshing swim.

The Hotel Manastir is a quiet and comfortable stay. You can order single, double or triple rooms. The dancing and teaching halls are in the hotel. ### **Daily Program:**

The seminar includes 5 hrs of dance lessons every day, and one singing lesson per day. Instrumental lesson schedules will depend on attendance.

Dance lessons will be taught by **Šani Rifati**, **Milo Destanovci** - both experts in traditional Romani dance - and **Jovica Blazevski**. **Milo** was born in Berovo. He also is an accomplished Zurna and KavaI player. Jovica is an experienced dance instructor and choreographer who worked with Tanec, the Macedonian national folklore

ensemble, for many years. He will offer dances from different regions of Macedonia, so as to garner a broader understanding of folk dances within the country.

### Instrumental lessons
